"Bushcraft is the use and practice of skills, thereby acquiring and developing knowledge and understanding, in order to survive and thrive in a natural environment."





Methods


We conducted two surveys:

- > the first one took place in December 2022 and regarded mainly the *Overnight in the forest program*, it included 13 questions.
- the second one was carried out in April 2023 and was focused more on the detailed characteristic of a bushcrafter, it consisted of 21 questions.



Our surveys included following questions which can be divided in certain thematic parts:

- 1. Personal data.
- 2. Experience in bushcraft and personal preferences.
- 3. Overnight in the forest program.




Personal data

He lives in a town with estimated numer of residents of 20, 000 - 100, 000 residents and currently has full-time job.




Place of origin




Experience in bushcraft and personal preferences

What is your favourite voivodeship to spend time in the forest?






Average frequency of sleeping in the forest for Polish bushcrafter is once in a month. He usually spends there 1 to 3 nights maximum.

His preferred type of accommodation includes a hammock or a tent, possibly situated close to the water or in the middle of the forest.




How would you rate the program *Overnight in the forest* on a scale of 1 to 5?




Average rating of *Overnight in the forest* program according to the gender of respondents
